We invite you to join us for a review of the Final Preliminary Plans for Reaches 5 and 6 of The Glade stream:

Location: The Basketball Court off of Hunting Horn Lane (see attached map) – we will have a tent and tables set up on the court for plan review and a lunchtime cookout.

Time: 9:00 AM – 2:00 PM (earlier if rain precludes walk)

Date: Saturday – July 25, 2009

Reach 5 starts at Soapstone Drive (across from the fire ring) and ends just upstream of the beaver area. Reach 6 starts below the beaver area and continues downstream to Twin Branches Road. A map of this area is attached to better illustrate the subject reaches.

The purpose of this meeting is to:

1. Show you the Final Preliminary Plans that reflect existing conditions and the preliminary design that incorporates comments received during the first preliminary plan meeting.
2. Walk the streams (be prepared for stickers, mud, and walking in water) and access areas to visualize them in conjunction with the Final Preliminary Plans.
